

Important Reminder

An In-Line Booth has one side exposed to an aisle and is generally arranged in a series along a straight line. They are also called “Linear Booths”. A Corner Booth is an In-Line Booth exposed to an aisle on two sides.

In applying for exhibit space, you have agreed to comply with the following rules:

Regardless of the number of In-Line Booths, exhibit construction and merchandise shall be arranged as not to obstruct the general view, nor hide the exhibits of neighboring exhibitors. The maximum height of 8’ is allowed only in the rear half of the booth with a 4’ height restriction imposed on all materials in the remaining space forward to the aisle. When three or more In-Line Booths are used in combination as a single exhibit space, the 4’ height limitation applies only to that portion of the exhibit space that is within 10’ of an adjoining booth.

Below is an example of an in-line booth. Regardless of what size your booth is (6’ x 10’, 8’ x 10’, 10’x10’), you will be expected to adhere to the line of site rules below.
